

## Bird Nest Cookies

1.5 cups milk chocolate chips,  
butterscotch chips, chow mein  
noodles  
36 candy eggs

Microwave chocolate and butterscotch chips in 30 second increments until smooth. Add noodles and toss until coated. For each cookie, spoon 2 tbsp of mixture onto parchment paper, shape into a nest and top with 3 candies.

Set until firm.

May that truth alone be your joy, peace, and comfort for all the seasons to come!






