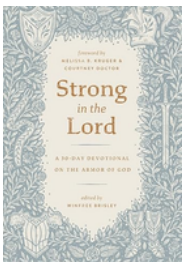

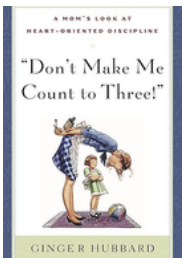

### A Note From Linda

Summer often brings a different rhythm. School ends, vacations begin, and daily routines become more relaxed. While time away from work or regular schedules can be refreshing, our relationship with God should not be set aside for the season.

## Ways To Grow This Summer:

- Read through a book of the Bible. Choose a book, such as John, Philippians, and James. Apply one thing that you learn every day.
- Pray while you walk. Turn a daily walk into a prayer walk of thanksgiving, confession and bringing requests to God.
- Memorize scripture. Commit to memorizing one verse a week during July and August.
- Reduce one distraction. Consider limiting social media, television, or another time-consuming activity. Use some of that reclaimed time for prayer, reading, or simply more time outside.
- Set one spiritual goal. Some suggestions include reading the New Testament, taking part in an online Bible course or study, or being intentional about showing hospitality towards other sisters in Christ.
